

NORTHERN NECK ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE

SCHEDULE GS-2-U

GENERAL SERVICE

1. AVAILABILITY

Available to Customers of the Cooperative where other rate schedules are not applicable and maximum demand does not exceed 50 kW, subject to the established rules and regulations. The capacity of individual single-phase motors shall not exceed ten (10) horsepower without the consent of the Cooperative.

2. TYPE OF SERVICE

Single-phase, and three phase, when available, 60 cycles, at available secondary voltages.

3. RATE (MONTHLY)

I. Distribution Delivery Charges:

Access Charge: \$22.33 per month

Demand Delivery Charges:

First 20 kW delivered @ \$0.00 per kW
Over 20 kW delivered @ \$5.00 per kW

Energy Delivery Charges:

All kWh delivered @ \$0.03444 per kWh

II. Electricity Supply Service Charges:

All kWh sold @ \$0.04665 per kWh

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4. DETERMINATION OF BILLING DEMAND

The Cooperative will install a demand meter suitable for measuring maximum demand on all services where load warrants. The Billing Demand for the current month shall be the maximum kilowatt demand established by the Customer for any period of fifteen consecutive minutes during the month for which the bill is rendered.

5. MINIMUM MONTHLY CHARGES

The minimum monthly charge for service shall be \$22.33

6. WHOLESALE POWER COST ADJUSTMENT CHARGE

The amount of charges calculated under the above rates are subject to increase or decrease under provision of the Cooperative's Wholesale Power Cost Adjustment Clause, Schedule "G."

7. TERMS OF CONTRACT

The Term of Contract is to be not less than twelve (12) months.
