



4. DETERMINATION OF BILLING DEMAND

Billing Demands shall be based on demands established in the current and most previous eleven months. The current month Billing Demand shall be the maximum kilowatt demand established by the Consumer for any period of fifteen (15) minutes during the month for which the bill is rendered, as indicated or recorded by demand meter, but not less than fifty-five percent (55%) of the highest demand established in the months of June through September of the preceding eleven months.

5. MINIMUM MONTHLY CHARGES

The minimum monthly Distribution Delivery charge for service shall be the highest one of the following charges:

- a) The minimum monthly charge as specified in the contract for service.
- b) \$360.00.

6. WHOLESALE POWER COST ADJUSTMENT CHARGE

The amount of charges calculated under the above rates are subject to increase or decrease under provisions of the Cooperative's Wholesale Power Cost Adjustment Clause, Schedule "G."

7. DETERMINATION OF rkVA DEMAND

The rkVA demand shall be billed to consumers with 500 kW or more of measured demand. The billing rkVA shall be the highest average rkVA measured in any period of fifteen consecutive minutes during the month for which the bill is rendered.

8. PRIMARY SERVICE DISCOUNT

If service is furnished at the Sellers primary distribution voltage, a discount shall apply to the charges specified in the applicable rate schedule. The Seller may meter at secondary voltage and adjust for transformer losses by use of loss compensators. The discount for primary service shall be three percent (3%) of the Distribution Delivery demand and energy charges.

9. TERM OF CONTRACT

The Term of Contract shall be not less than twelve (12) months.
