SCHEDULE R-6

RESIDENTIAL SERVICE

1. AVAILABILITY

Available to Customers of the Cooperative for a single-family residence or a combination of farm and one single family residence served by a single meter, subject to the established rules and regulations. Service under this schedule is limited to single family occupancy. The capacity of individual single-phase motors shall not exceed ten (10) horsepower without the consent of the Cooperative.

2. TYPE OF SERVICE

Single-phase, and three-phase, where available, 60 cycles, at available secondary voltage.

3. RATE (MONTHLY)

I. Distribution Delivery Charges:

Access Charge:

Single Phase	\$31.00 per month
Three Phase	\$54.18 per month

Energy Delivery Charges:

All kWh delivered	@	\$0.03427 per kWh

Demand Delivery Charge:

II. Electricity Supply Service Charges:

All kWh sold June - September	@	\$0.09270 per kWh
All kWh sold October - May	@	\$0.08019 per kWh

Note: The above Distribution Delivery Charges and Electricity Supply Service Charges apply to those Customers who have the Cooperative as their energy service provider. Only the Distribution Delivery Charges apply to those Customers who have an Electricity Supplier other than the Cooperative as their energy provider.

4. **BILLING DEMAND:**

The billing demand shall be the Customer's maximum kilowatt integrated demand measured for any 60-minute clock hour period from 6:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. during the month for which the bill is rendered.

5. **MINIMUM MONTHLY CHARGE**

The minimum monthly Distribution Delivery charge for service shall be the applicable Access Charge.

6. **POWER COST ADJUSTMENT**

The amount of charges calculated under the above rates for Energy Supply Service is subject to increase or decrease under provisions of the Cooperative's Power Cost Adjustment Clause, Schedule PCA.

7. **TERM OF CONTRACT**

The Term of Contract is to be not less than twelve months.
