

NORTHERN NECK ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE

SCHEDULE T-5

TOU SERVICE

1. AVAILABILITY

Available to Customers of the Cooperative that are being served or would normally be served under Residential Service, General Service or Church Service Rate Schedules where load is not in excess of 20 kW. Net Metering customers are not eligible for this rate.

2. TYPE OF SERVICE

Single-phase, and three-phase, where available, 60 cycles, at available secondary voltage.

3. RATE (MONTHLY)

I. Distribution Delivery Charges:

Access Charge:

Single Phase	\$34.60 per month
Three Phase	\$54.18 per month

Energy Delivery Charges:

All kWh delivered @ \$0.03400 per kWh

Demand Delivery Charge:

All kW of Billing Demand @ \$0.10 per kW

II. Electricity Supply Service Charges:

On peak kWh June - September	@ \$0.19367 per kWh
On peak kWh October - May	@ \$0.09614 per kWh
All off peak kWh	@ \$0.05587 per kWh

Note: The above Distribution Delivery Charges and Electricity Supply Service Charges apply to those Customers who have the Cooperative as their energy service provider. Only the Distribution Delivery Charges apply to those Customers who have an Electricity Supplier other than the Cooperative as their energy provider.

4. BILLING DEMAND

The billing demand shall be the Customer's maximum kilowatt integrated demand measured for any 60-minute clock hour period from 6:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. during the month for which the bill is rendered.

5. DETERMINATION OF ON-PEAK AND ON-PEAK HOURS

- I. Summer On-Peak hours are: Weekdays, 3 PM to 8 PM
- II. Non-Summer On-Peak hours are: Weekdays, 6 AM to 8 AM and 3 PM to 8 PM
- III. Off-Peak hours are: All hours not included in the "On-Peak hours" above.

6. MINIMUM MONTHLY CHARGE

The minimum monthly Distribution Delivery charge for service shall be the applicable Access Charge.

7. POWER COST ADJUSTMENT

The amount of charges calculated under the above rates for Energy Supply Service is subject to increase or decrease under provisions of the Cooperative's Power Cost Adjustment Clause, Schedule PCA.

8. TERM OF CONTRACT

The Term of Contract is to be not less than twelve months.
